

Huruma Centre COVID-19 Update
April 30, 2021

At the time of this writing, the US State Department continues to issue a Level 4: Do Not Travel Health Notice for Tanzania because of uncertainty regarding the status of the COVID-19 pandemic in Tanzania. There is little concrete information about testing, case numbers, and deaths. At the same time, knowledge from the many contacts that BKB has in the Iringa region provides a bit more local information.

Since July 2020, secondary students from the Huruma Centre have been attending Diocese boarding schools. No cases have been reported among either the students or staff of those schools. Likewise, no cases of COVID-19 have been reported among either the children or staff of the Huruma Centre itself. With our BKB Coordinators now on the ground and working in Iringa, we will receive monthly updates from the Huruma Centre.
